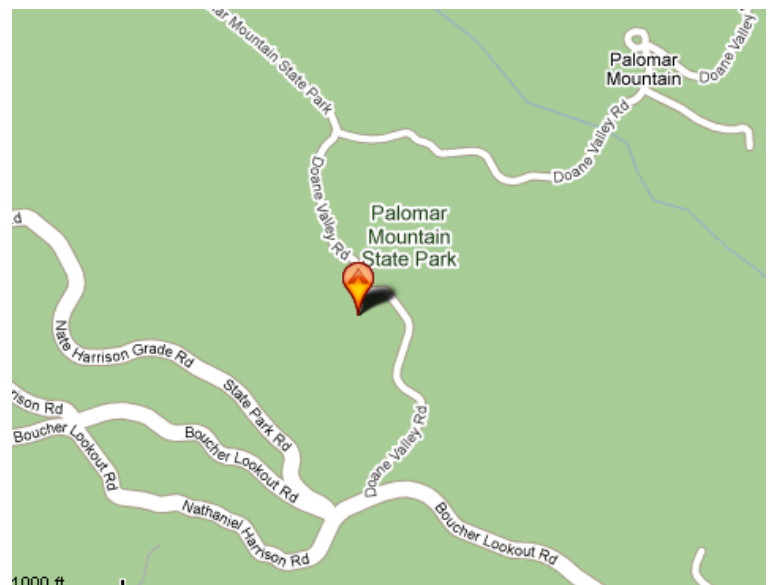
**GETTING THERE FROM ORANGE COUNTY:**
